2. Entry Deadline is **JUNE 1st**
3. **ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 1 AND PAYMENT ENCLOSED OR A \$1.00 LATE FEE PER ENTRY WILL BE CHARGED.**
4. Exhibits are due on Saturday, August 1st, 2009 from 11:00am to 4:00 pm.
5. Exhibits will be released on Sunday, August 9th, 2009 from 11:00am to 4:00pm. Anything not picked up at that time will be considered abandoned. **As always WCFA and Superintendent are not responsible for exhibits not picked up by the posted times. The Fair board and Superintendents are not required to store any exhibit left after the close of the Youth Building.**
6. All Specimen Vegetables must be placed on a disposable dish.
7. All plants that need to be watered must have a catch dish under them to keep water and dirt off floor.
8. **Exhibitors may exhibit two (2) items per section but only one (1) per class.**
9. Special time for Exhibitor to view their judged projects will be Monday evening from 8:00pm to 9:00pm
10. Objective: Exhibitor must grow all crops themselves. They must be picked or displayed as close to maturity as possible.

SECTION - 1: Youth Potted Plants

Rules:

1. All Vegetable plants must be grown in containers.
2. Size of Container must be limited to weight that exhibitor can carry.
3. Garden will be judge on the basis of quality of plants and fruit produce.

SECTION - 7: Vegetable Garden

Rules:

1. All vegetables exhibited are to be grown by the exhibitor.
2. Containers for exhibiting vegetables will be provided by exhibitor.
3. The number of specimens of one kind or variety of vegetable to exhibit is: (1) bunch of Broccoli, leeks or green onion, (1) plant of Celery, (1) specimen of eggplant, pumpkin, Winter Squash Cabbage, Watermelon Cantaloupe, (3) specimens Rutabagas, Summer Squash, (5) specimens- beets, carrots, sweet corn, cucumbers, Kohlrabi, Okra, dry onions Parsnips, peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Salsify, Sweet Potatoes, Tomatoes or Turnips, (12) specimens-Green or Waxed Beans, Lima Beans, Brussel sprouts, Peas or Soy beans
4. Since Leafy vegetables do not hold well they are not recommended to exhibit.
