GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Show time: Saturday, August 13, 2011 at 9:00 am

Test: Saturday, July 30, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.

RULES:

1. Open to registered 4-H youth who have turned in their fees and paperwork on time.
2. Live animal showmanship will consist of animals from each of the Livestock and Small Animal Divisions. All participants are expected to show live animals, which will consist of Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Swine, Sheep, Rabbits, and Poultry.
3. To qualify for Master Stockman competition the participant must place 1st or 2nd in showmanship class in the livestock and small animal division.
4. If an exhibitor places in two or more divisions, then the exhibitor will choose only one division under which to enter. There will be no replacement chosen for the exhibitor in the division he/ she did not select.
5. Contest will be scored on:
 - A. Showmanship
 - B. Knowledge
 - C. Personal Appearance of Exhibitor
6. Questions will encompass all aspects of breeding, showing, market, Veterinary Science, and animal husbandry. Questions for this contest are formulated from information obtained from Michigan State University Extension Publications. Master Stockman Guides may be obtained from the 4-H Livestock Developmental Committee.
7. All participants must be in show attire.
8. Master Stockman winners from previous year(s) will be allowed to compete providing they meet the requirements as stated in rule 2 above.
