WAYNE COUNTY HOMEMAKER
CONTEST RULES**

RULES:

1. Open to all residents of Wayne County, 19 years or older, who enter the Community Arts Building. The winner is eligible to represent Wayne County Fair at the Michigan State Fair Homemaker Competition.
2. Must submit a pre-registration application and a picture to compete for Homemaker with the Fair Entry Office no later than Saturday, August 6, 2011 at 5 p.m. Picture must be included.
3. Person must have entries in any four of the following categories: Horticulture, Floriculture, Canned Goods, Needlecraft (other than sewing), Baked Goods, Fine Arts, Sewing, Hobbies, and Crafts. You may entry additional categories.
4. Person must volunteer 4 (four) or more hours to the Wayne County Fair for the year they are running for Homemaker. Documentation is required. To receive extra points you must have 8 (eight) or more volunteer hours during the current year. Person must also attend at least 3 Wayne county Fair Association functions and or promotions (i.e. Parades, Dinners etc.)
5. Homemaker will be judged on a point system as stated below

5 Extra points for 8 (eight) or more volunteer hours

Category (A) is based on total ribbon points divided by number of entries.

Category (B) is based on total points.

Category (C) is based on number of hours volunteered to the Wayne County Fair for 2011.

Trophy will be awarded to the Wayne County Homemaker of the Year
