Rules:

1. Exhibit fee is \$1.00 per Class
2. Entry Deadline is **JUNE 1st**
3. **ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 1 AND PAYMENT ENCLOSED OR A \$1.00 LATE FEE PER ENTRY WILL BE CHARGED.**
4. Exhibits are due on Saturday, August 6, 2011 from 11:00am to 4:00 pm.
5. In order to process exhibits effectively all exhibits must be in youth building by 4:30 with tags attached)
6. Exhibits will be released on Sunday, August 14, 2011 from 11:00am to 4:00pm. Anything not picked up at that time will be considered abandoned. As always WCFA and Superintendent are not responsible for exhibits not picked up by the posted times. The Fair board and Superintendents are not required to store any exhibit left after the close of the Youth Building.
7. All Specimen Vegetables must be placed on a disposable dish.
8. All plants that need to be watered must have a catch dish under them to keep water and dirt off floor.
9. Exhibitors may exhibit two (2) items per section but only one (1) per class.
10. Special time for Exhibitor to view their judged projects will be Monday evening from 8:00pm to 9:00pm
11. Objective: Exhibitor must grow all crops themselves. They must be picked or displayed as close to maturity as possible.
12. All plants are considered perishable thus we will only receive on August 6, 2011.
13. Superintendents will water plants on Sunday & Monday but Exhibitors must water at closing every day.
14. Superintendents has the right to remove any dead leaves or branches to enhance the look of plants.
15. Last day at closing for ½ hour you may pick up your exhibits with tag only. If you do not pick up then you must return at designated time only. Any exhibits pick up without Superintendent release will be considered as a non- release and at the discretion of board may impose a fine not to exceed the premium won.

SECTION - 1: Youth Potted Plants

Rules:

1. All crop plants must be grown in containers.
2. Size of Container must be limited to weight that exhibitor can carry.
3. Garden will be judge on the basis of quality of plants and fruit produce.
