Pen Fee: \$3.00 per head

Rules:

1. All pens must be cleaned before 9:00 a.m. each day; birds must be fed and watered daily.
2. Two entries per class per exhibitor.
3. Maximum of fifteen birds per exhibitor and a meat pen of each species.
4. Exhibitors will provide their own water containers. These containers must be of suitable size and kind to keep from being tipped over or spilled. Failure to do this may cost you demerits for dirty pens and a loss of premiums.
5. Exhibitors will provide their own feed.
6. Poultry will be checked by superintendent or assistant before entry into cages. They must have proof of a negative Pullorum test for each bird or be tested upon entry. Pullorum testing will be conducted, contact W.C.F.A. for date.
7. Exhibitors aged 5, 6, and 7 may show through the Protégé Program.
8. Ducks, geese, turkeys, and meat class chickens must be banded with a numbered identification band.
9. All market animals must be caught by 4:00 p.m. on auction day.
10. All birds sold in the Livestock Auction must be caught by the exhibitor and placed in your own carrying cages by 9:00 p.m. on the day before they are released. Show your purchasers that you appreciate their buying your livestock by having them ready to take on release day.
11. Accumulation of three demerits for unkept birds, cages, or feed and water dishes means forfeiture of premiums.
12. Due at Fair on Sunday, August 12, 2007, from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m.
13. Meat birds should be the same sex and size.
14. Entry deadline is **JULY 1**.
15. **ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JULY 1 AND PAYMENT ENCLOSED OR A \$1.00 PER HEAD LATE FEE WILL BE CHARGED.** Do in duplicate and send one copy to Superintendent, C/O W. C. F. A., P. O. Box 308, Belleville, Michigan 48112.
16. Exhibitors must be 8 years old as of December 31st of current year.
17. Market birds must be permanently banded before being placed in cages.
18. Animals will not be released from their stalls until August 19, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums.
19. All barn decoration must remain up until after 11:00 p.m. on August 18, 2007. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums.
