Pen Fee: \$2.00 per head

Rules:

1. Exhibitors must be 8 years old as of January 1st of the current year.
2. Please be sure your birds are healthy, clean, and vermin-free before check in. Any bird determined to have lice or mites or to show symptoms of disease will be required to leave the barn immediately. Condition – bird must be clean, healthy, have good feather quality and be prepared for show.
3. Two entries per class per exhibitor. Maximum of fifteen birds per exhibitor.
4. Meat birds must be the same sex, and should be the same size.
5. Entry deadline is **JUNE 1. ALL CLASS ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 1. PEN FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY OR A \$1.00 PER HEAD LATE FEE WILL BE CHARGED.** Late entries will only be accepted if barn space permits.
6. Mandatory Tagging/Banding date will be held on July 24, 2010 from 12-4pm at Rabbit/Poultry barn. All market birds and market rabbits must be brought to Fairgrounds to be tagged/tattooed on this date before fair starts.
7. Chickens, geese, ducks, turkeys: Due at fair on Sunday, August 1, 2010, from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m.
8. Pens will be assigned as poultry is checked in by the Superintendents.
9. For poultry over 6 months of age, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have proof of a negative Pullorum test. Testing will be available on the Wayne County Fair Grounds at a time to be determined.
10. The Superintendent's for identification will band all meat birds and waterfowl.
11. Exhibitors are to provide their own shavings, feed, and dishes (dishes need to be of suitable size).
12. All Exhibitors are responsible for doing Barn Duty.
13. Waterfowl must stay in pens until judging is over.
14. All pens must be cleaned by 10:00 a.m. everyday except Tuesday. Tuesday is show day and pens must be cleaned by 9:00 a.m.
15. All waterfowl must be caught before 4:00 p.m. on auction day and before 7:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 8, 2010.
16. Accumulation of three demerits for unkempt birds, cages, feed and water dishes, and no Barn Duty is forfeiture of premiums.
17. Animals will not be released from their stalls until August 8, 2010 at 8:00 a.m. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums. Market animals may leave with processor after 11pm on Saturday of Fair week. Auction animals may be taken to a livestock sale barn after 11pm on Saturday of Fair week.
18. All barn decoration must remain up until after 11:00 p.m. on August 7, 2010. Early removal will result in the loss of all premiums.
19. All turkeys must weigh a minimum of 16 lbs. in order to show at the Wayne County Fair.

SECTION – 31: Record Books

Rules:

1. All youth participating in the poultry market classes are required to enter the Small Animal Record Book Class for each type of poultry shown.
2. The purpose of the Record Book is to keep record of purchases and expenditures associated with the market project. Proper management skills and record keeping for the market animal project is the goal.
3. Records will be judged on the following:
 - a. Accuracy: 50%
 - b. Completeness: 30%
 - c. Neatness: 20%
4. Market Poultry projects entered in this class must have met the possession date.
5. Market Record Books are available from Laurie Rivetto (4-H Educator).
6. All record books must be completed and turned in to Laurie Rivetto on Tuesday, August 3, 2010 from 12 (noon) – 2pm.
7. Exhibitors and parents are not allowed to be present during the evaluation of the record books.
